



# FREE TUTORING FOR ADOPTED CHILDREN



The State of Michigan Adoption Subsidy Program will cover the cost of up to 5 hours per week of professional tutoring for qualifying students. Children who meet the following criteria are eligible:

- ADOPTED from foster care through the State of Michigan
- Grade 1-12, up to age 18
- Have a medically diagnosed learning disability (i.e. Dyslexia, ADHD, PTSD, etc.)
- Has a 504 or IEP plan issued by their school OR is failing a grade

Ally Learning is a vendor for the State of Michigan and provides this Adoption Subsidy tutoring. We offer in-person tutoring at our Livonia and Redford Learning Centers, or **Online Tutoring** using an application called "Zoom." Using Zoom, students can upload their homework and work on it in real time with our tutors, see their tutor face-to-face, watch the tutor write on a virtual white board... we create a "virtual classroom" right in the safety and comfort of your own home!
